### Directions:

Chapel off Chapel is located on Little Chapel St, parallel to (east of) Chapel Street in between Malvern Road and King Street nearby the Princess Gardens.

## Public Transport:

<b>Trams:</b> If catching from the city (Flinders Street Station), take tram number 72 and get off at the Malvern Road and Chapel Street intersection. (refer to * for further directions)  If coming from east of the city, catch tram to Church or Chapel St (Church Street turns into Chapel Street) and then catch tram number 78 or 79 and get off at the Malvern Road and Chapel Street Intersection. (Refer to * for further directions)	<b>Trains:</b> Take the Sandringham Line train from Flinders Street station to Prahran station. From Prahran station walk east along Greville Street (towards Chapel Street), Turn left into Chapel Street (north) and then right (east) into Walker Street (second street on the right) and then finally left into Little Chapel Street (approx 10 min walk from station).

\* From the Malvern Road and Chapel Street Intersection walk east one block and turn right (south) into Little Chapel Street (approx 2 minute walk).

## Parking:

If driving a car to the event the best place to park will be the Kings Parking lot at the southern end of Little Chapel Street. When turning into Little Chapel Street off Malvern Road, the parking lot is down past Chapel Off Chapel at the end of Little Chapel Street. Be early if choosing this option as parking can be limited (approx a 5 min walk from Parking Lot to Chapel Off Chapel)

## Accessibility:

The room that will be used at Chapel Off Chapel is fully accessible for a person in a wheelchair.

## Cancellation Policy:

After booking if you are unable to attend a substitute will be welcome. A 75% refund is available up until 19th May. No refunds after that date.
