Public Transport: Trains: Take either the Epping or Hurstbridge Line train from Flinders Street station to West Richmond Station. From station walk south until on Bridge Rd and then go east along Bridge Rd. When you cross Church St the next major building on the north side of Bridge Rd is the Richmond Town Hall. Allow 30 mins from Flinders St station.
Trams: Tram Number 75 runs along Spencer and Flinders St and continues past the Richmond Town Hall. Tram 78 and 79 also run up and down Church/ Chapel St. With all trams exit at the Bridge Rd/ Church St intersection
Parking: Parking available at the rear of Richmond Plaza, turn off Church st into Cameron St and then off Cameron st into Henty st.
Accessibility: The Richmond Town Hall has a lift however it is out of order. If you require a lift inform Jake via email so an alternate route can be devised.
